CONCEPT OF PRIVACY

Without some form of censorship, propaganda in the strict sense of the word is impossible. In order to conduct propaganda, there must be some barrier between the public and the event. Access to the real environment must be limited, before anyone can create a pseudo-environment that he thinks wise or desirable. For while people who have direct access can misconceive what they see, no one else can decide how they shall misconceive it, unless he can decide how they shall look and at what. The military censorship is the simplest form of barrier but by no means the most important because it is known to exist, and is therefore in certain measure agreed to and discounted.

At different times and for different subjects, some men impose and other men accept a particular standard of security. The frontier between what is concealed fades gradually because it is believed to be none of the public's business. The notion of what consists of a person's private affairs is elastic. Whether the reasons for privacy are good or bad, the barriers exist. Privacy is insisted upon all kinds of places in public affairs. Therefore ask yourself how you got at the facts on which you base your opinion. They will reveal the distance which often separates your public opinion from the event with which it deals.
